The poster session is limited to 30 posters (maximum of five per hospital). If more than 30 poster abstracts are received by the deadline, the South Carolina Nursing Excellence Conference Poster Committee will make a determination for entry. If an abstract is selected for a poster presentation, at least one author, no more than two authors, need to be present at the poster during poster sessions outlined in the agenda.
