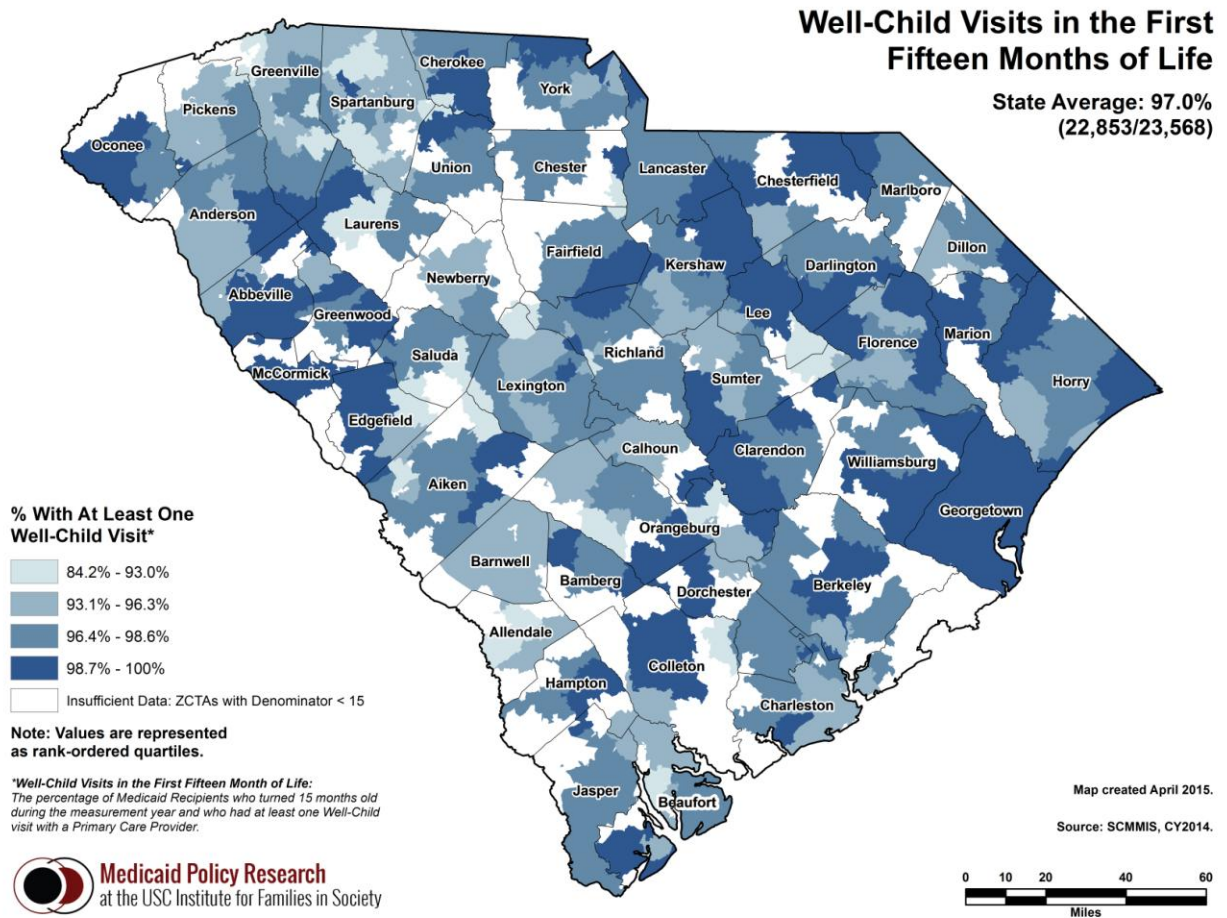


Well child visits among Medicaid population in South Carolina

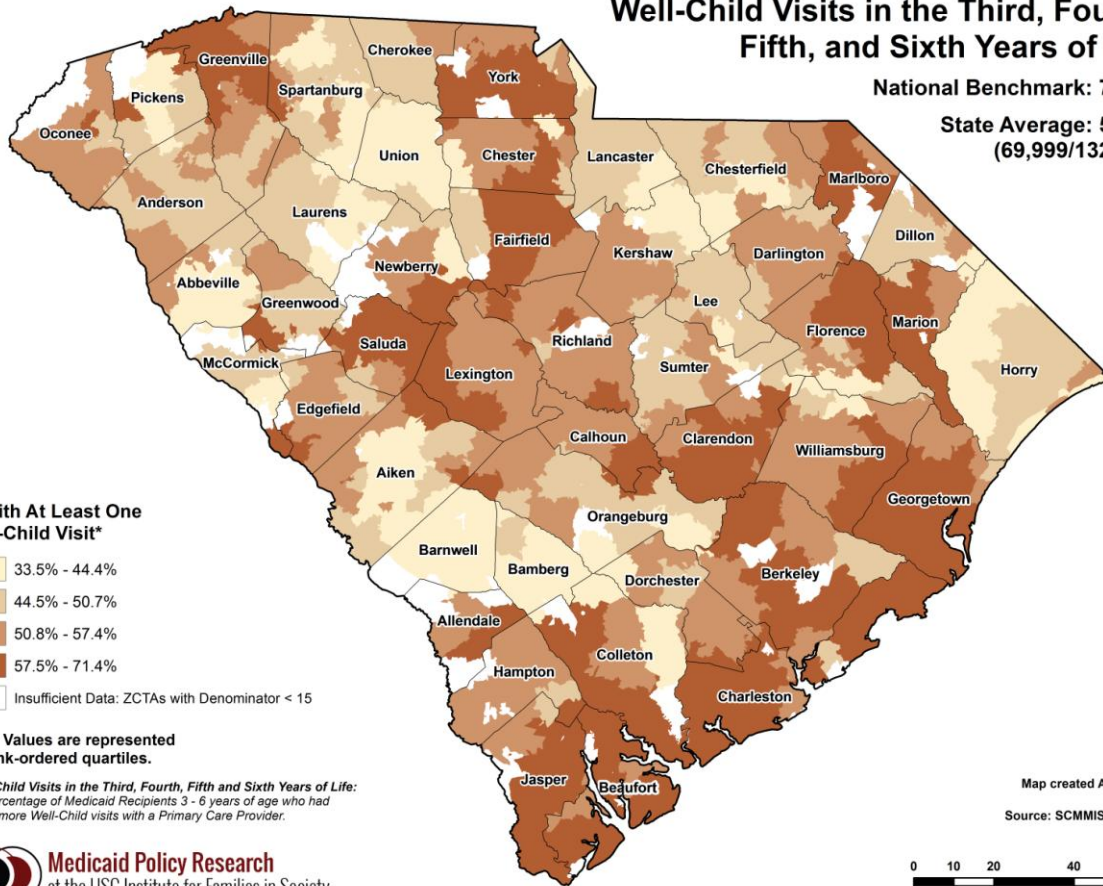

National Benchmark: 71.5%

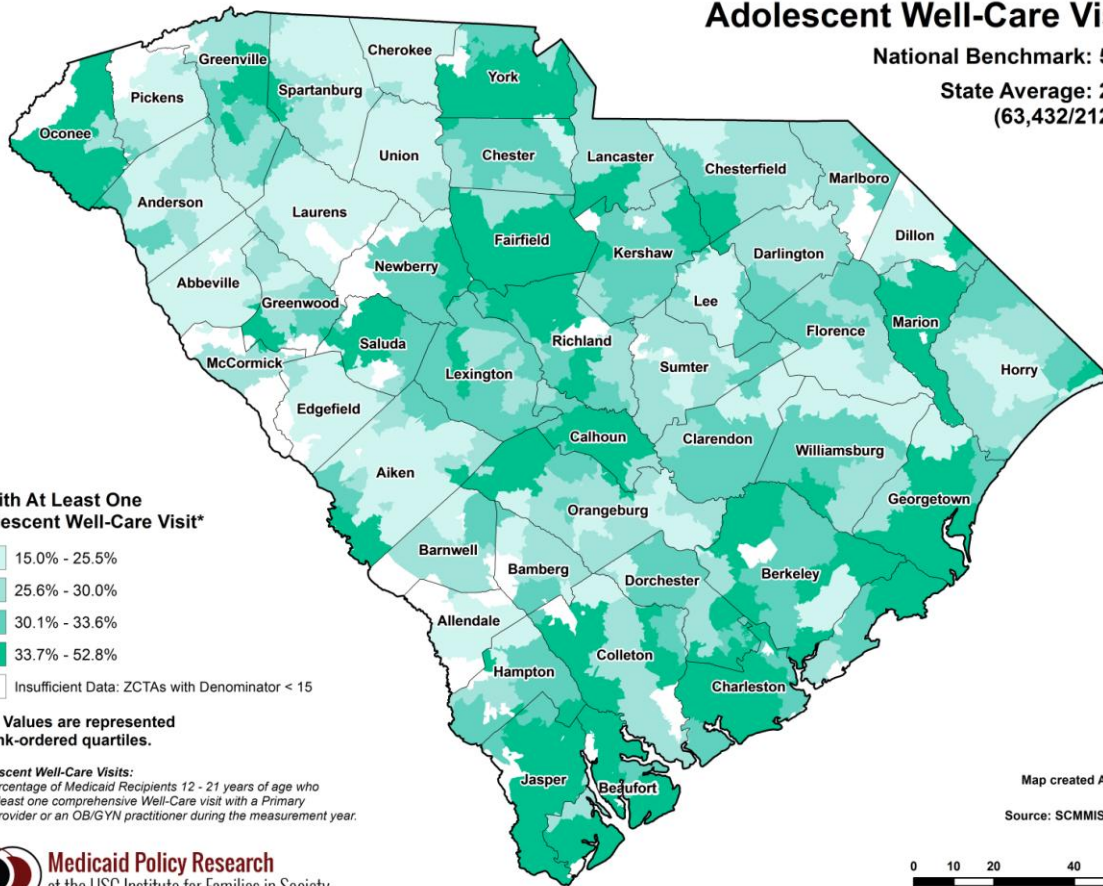
State Average: 52.9%
